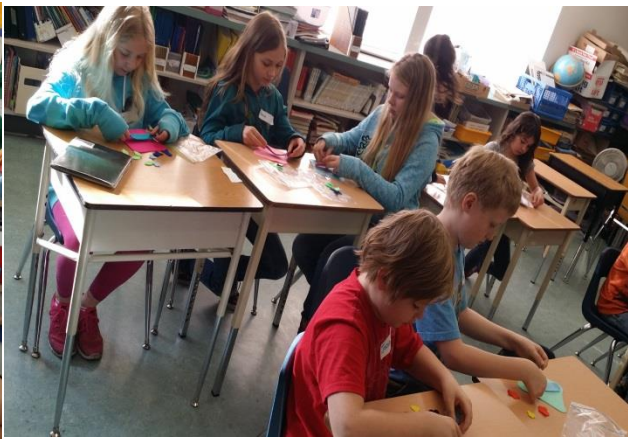


METIS DAY AT DEWDNEY ELEMENTARY – MARCH 27, 2015
